
## 9 Bus ₤ tickets 1935-1966

Extra 3/8 longer but width 1 1/8". **13 sections (13-1).** Depot code letter/series letter as before.1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>d and values over 11d have 2 horizontal red bars.


1d grey, 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>d light blue, 2d pink, 3d green, 4d salmon, 5d orange, 6d yellow, 7d white, 8d blue, 9d lilac, 10d dark blue, 11d buff, 1/- pink, 1/3 salmon, 1/6 orange, 1/9 yellow, 2/- white. (2 red bars on values over 11d).

Extra 3/8 longer but width 1 1/8". **20 sections (20-11 & 10-1).** Depot code.Values over 11d have 2 horizontal red bars.

1d grey, 1d brown (temporary), 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>d light blue, 2d pink, 3d green, 4d salmon, 5d orange, 6d yellow, 7d white, 8d blue, 9d lilac, 10d dark blue,11d white?, 1/- pink, 1/3 salmon, 1/6 orange, 1/9 yellow, 2/- white<sup>1</sup>. Also 1/1 orange (Newcastle), 1 /2 lilac (Newcastle).

1d grey<sup>2</sup>, 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>d light blue, 2d pink, 3d green, 4d salmon, 5d orange, 6d yellow, 7d white, 8d blue, 9d lilac, 10d dark blue, 11d. 2 red lines

Continued unchanged: 1/- pink bar, 1/3 salmon with 2 red lines, 1/6 orange with 2 red lines, 1/9 yellow with 2 red lines, 2/- white with 2 red lines. Also 1/1 orange<sup>3</sup>, 1/2 lilac.

Common tickets for buses & trams

From 1951until the end of trams in 1961 both tram and bus tickets were identical except for depot letters.

The following were only tram depots: U, K, FM, N, D, T, M, R

The following were only bus depots: L, B, WB, RW, P, K, BV, MV, Y

The following were both or converted tram/bus depots: AM(tram)/ E(bus), W, S(tram)/N(bus), NC, RW

Trolley buses originally used RS, and later T. The Brighton line used T.

1d grey, 2d pink, 3d green, 4d salmon, 6d yellow, 8d blue, 9d lilac, 10d dark blue, 11d white with 2 horiz green bars, 1/- white 2 horiz blue bars, 1/6 white with 2 horiz orange bars, 1/6 with thin vert orange bar, 2/- white with 2 red horiz bars.

Some have advertisements for departmental services on the back in black.

Some have advertisements for departmental services on the back in black. Note that as the tramlines were closed, surplus tram depot stocks were used by buses and vice versa<sup>4</sup>.
