# REPORT OF THE POSTMASTER-GENERAL OF QUEENSLAND FOR THE YEAR 1876.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by Command.

To His Excellency Sir Arthur Edward Kennedy, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Administrator of the Government of the Colony of Queensland and its Dependencies.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY,-

I have the honour to present to your Excellency the following Report of the operations of the Postal Department during the year 1876.

## TORRES STRAITS MAIL SERVICE.

In the report for the year 1875 it was stated that by the time-table arranged for 1876 a saving in time would be effected, and, although instructions were, it is understood, issued by the Eastern and Australian Company to the captains of their mail steamers not to anticipate the time of arrival at Brisbane by more than 24 hours, the average duration of the inward voyages from Singapore to Brisbane has not been much longer than in the preceding year.

In order to induce the Eastern and Australian Company to continue the previous practice of running the contract steamers at a high rate of speed, it was proposed that a premium should be given for every twenty-four hours' earlier arrival at Brisbane than that shown in the time-table arranged in terms of the contract; but the contractors declined to make any arrangement to this effect.

The accompanying tables show that the average time occupied from Brisbane to London via Brindisi was 53 days 9 hours, and via Southampton 61 days 13 hours. Owing to the early arrival of the steamer at Singapore a detention occurred at that place on four occasions of upwards of 4 days, and on three occasions of over 3 days.

The inward transit has occupied an average of 50 days 6 hours via Brindisi, and 58 days 13 hours via Southampton.

These averages compare very favourably with the services via Melbourne and San Francisco, as will be seen in the following table:—

Advantage was taken of the calling of the Torres Straits mail steamers at Cooktown to make arrangements for landing and shipping English and other mails, and the necessary action was taken in connection with the London and other offices. The steamers have called regularly since August, 1876, without any extra expense being incurred by the Government.

Cairns, at Trinity Bay, and Thornsborough, at the Hodgkinson River, have been included in the sorting lists; and correspondence for these places is now sent via Cooktown.

During the past year the average time of the inward trips from Singapore to Brisbane was 19 hours less than that allowed by the time-table, and the average time of the outward trips from Brisbane to Singapore was 2 days and 17 hours less than the average of the time allowed by the time-table.

The outward trip was performed, on the average, during 1876, in 2 days 8 hours less time than during the preceding year, whilst the average time occupied in performing the inward trips was about the same in both years.

No action was taken during the past year with reference to the forwarding of mails by the Messageries Maritimes line of steamers.

#### MAIL SERVICE BETWEEN BRISBANE AND NORTHERN PORTS.

On the 16th December last, a contract, in lieu of that terminating in January, 1877, was entered into with the Australasian Steam Navigation Company, substituting a weekly for a fortnightly service between Brisbane and the northern ports, including Cairns, from the 1st January, 1877, for the sum of £7,400 per annum for three (3) years, terminable after one year by six months' notice from either

## TRAVELLING POST OFFICES ON THE SOUTHERN AND WESTERN RAILWAY.

Some years ago it became a practice to send letters by the railway guards for the purpose of being posted at the terminal stations. The number of letters so sent became so numerous that, although the practice was considered to be irregular, additional accommodation was afforded by means of post office boxes attached to the guards' vans, and the guards were controlled by regulations, and paid twelve pounds per annum each, for duties connected with this matter, and also for acting as mail guards, and delivering and receiving mails, at each station. It was found, however, that this interfered too much with the guards' proper duty, and the Commissioner for Railways intimated to this office, in August, 1876, that after the close of the year, the attention of the guards on the Southern and Western Railway must be given exclusively to railway duties. It therefore became necessary to provide for the post office work, and arrangements were made for the establishment of travelling post offices under the charge of mail officers appointed by this Department, at which all the ordinary business could be transacted, such as the purchase of stamps, registration, and posting. As this system only came into operation on the first of January, 1877, further remarks on this subject must be deferred until the next annual report.
